



Searching PubMed: 3 Options

PubMed.gov Keyword search for broadest possible results---usually returns many non-relevant results.

Search PubMed **Search**

Advanced

Advanced search offers many different criteria for searching, including Title/Abstract, author, and institutional affiliation.

more than 30 million citations for biomedical literature from MEDLINE, life science journals, and online books. Links to full-text content from PubMed Central and publisher web sites.

Use MeSH terms to search; subject headings designed for best searching strategy. Highly recommended, but will exclude very recent articles.

Please note: the best searches often incorporate more than one of these options.





UTKey Bookmark

This bookmark helps you access UTK Libraries' subscriptions without having to navigate through the library website. Whenever you're blocked from viewing the full text of an article, click on the bookmark to prompt a NetID login. The proxy bookmark should work as long as the session is active. If the session "breaks," just click on the bookmark again.

You can install the bookmark by one of these methods:







PICO

The first stage of any evidence-based research is formulating an answerable question. A well-formulated question will facilitate the search for evidence and will assist you in determining whether the evidence is relevant to your question.

An answerable question has a format that follows the PICO concept. The acronym translates to:

- P – Populations/People/Patient/Problem
- I – Intervention(s)
- C – Comparison
- O – Outcome

Example:

P (Problem or Patient or Population)	hospital acquired infection
I (intervention/indicator)	hand washing
C (comparison)	no hand washing; other solution; masks
O (outcome of interest)	reduced infection

Translating a Clinical Question to a Database Search

33 PICO(T) Format

- Population**
 - Characteristics: Age, gender, ethnicity
 - Health issue: diabetes, access to healthcare
- Intervention**
 - Ex: drug, surgery, ed program, policy
 - Setting, geography
- Comparison**
 - Ex: no intervention, common practice
 - optional
- Outcome**
 - Ex: blood glucose, BMI
 - timing
- Type of studies**
 - Type of questions
 - Type of studies
