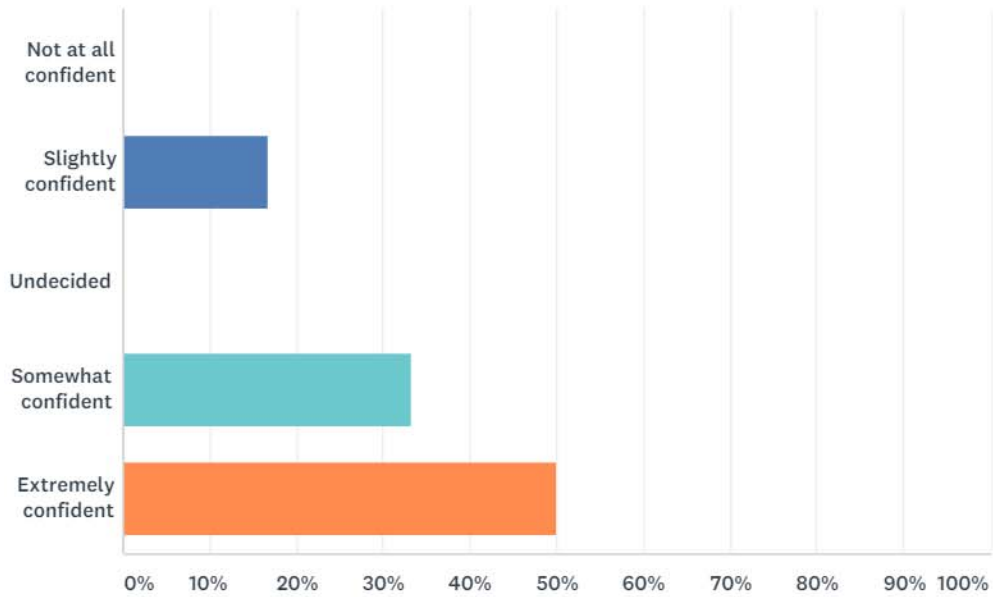


Q1 After attending this session, please rate how confident you would currently be navigating the academic promotion process
