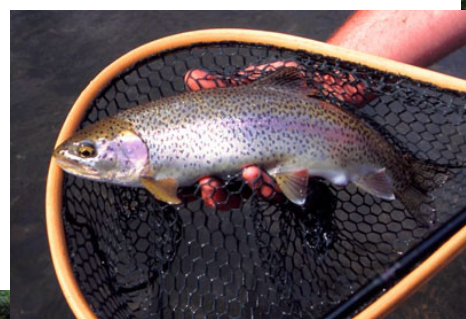
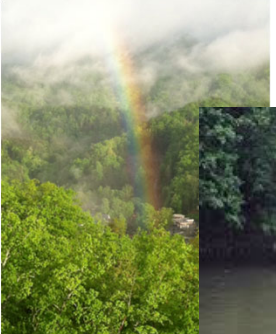
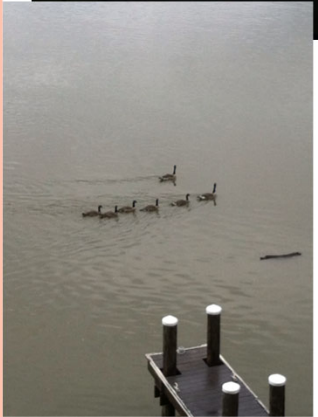
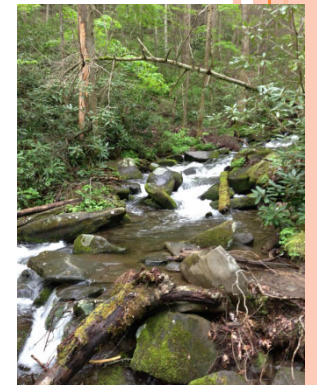
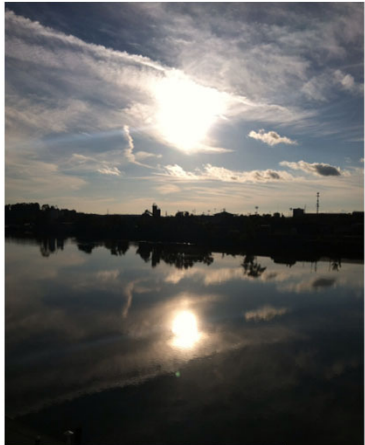
RED CROSS VOLUNTEER AT UT VOLS GAMES
