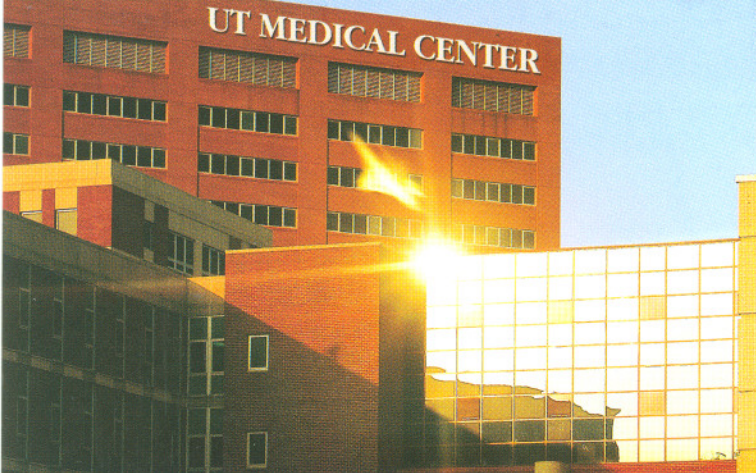

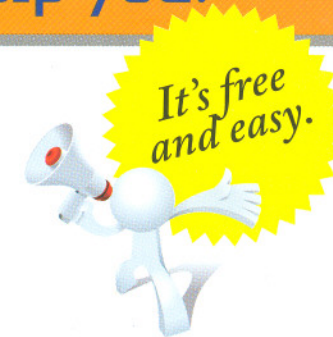

- What is the latest treatment for my cancer?
- What is the definition of a medical word my doctor used?
- What clinical trials are being done on my disease?
