**DOCLINE Highlights:**

- ESEA (Electronic South Eastern Atlantic) is a Free/reciprocal routing group and usually fills within 24 hrs.
- South Eastern Network on DOCLINE (SEND)- reciprocal consortium coordinated by Nedra Cook. Let her know if you'd like to join this group.
- Tip- Put a Group in the routing table (ie. ESEA, Free Share, etc) instead of listing individual libraries.
  - Let Beth know what groups you belong to so she can add them to your profile
- SERHOLD- not shelf list- is what you can lend
- ILL requests have been going down over past years due to the fact that people have better access to what they need, copyright prohibits some lending, and free access is more available.
- Over 50% of material is over 20 years old
- 56% of loans are emailed PDFs
- 84% of requests are completed on 1<sup>st</sup> route

- 96.5% of requests are completed on 2<sup>nd</sup> route
- 3.5% of requests require more than 2 routes.
- TIP- Call Beth Westcott to put a hold on DOCLINE requests if you go on vacation, etc.
- TIP- make sure you have “county” listed in profile
- You will receive DOCLINE reports twice a year to check borrowing and lending stats and to know what you owe to Copyright Clearance Center.
