Participating site(s): all Clinical MFM, MICU, SICU, and Elective blocks occur at the Primary Site, University of Tennessee Medical Center. Course work may occur at the Primary Site or at the University of Tennessee, Knoxville campus.

Elective Options:

- 1. **Family Planning /Complex Contraception**, with our Reproductive and Family Planning Specialist 4 weeks
- 2. **Medical Critical Care**, with our Pulmonology and Critical Care Medicine Faculty 4 weeks
- 3. Addiction Medicine, with our MFM faculty, Psychology, and Addiction Medicine 4 weeks
- 4. **Fetal echocardiology**, with our Pediatric Cardiologists 4 weeks, but also will be distributed throughout the year in diabetic clinic.
- 5. **Obstetric Anesthesia**, with our Obstetric Anesthesiologists 2 or 4 weeks, may be taken in conjunction with another selection.
- 6. **Adult Infectious Diseases**, with Adult ID Specialists and Infection Control Team 2 or 4 weeks, may be taken in conjunction with another selection.
- 7. NICU (2 weeks) / Genetics (2 weeks) total of 4 weeks
- 8. Embryology (2 weeks) / placental pathology (2 weeks) total of 4 weeks
- 9. Additional Research or course work time 2 or 4 weeks, may be taken in conjunction with another selection.

PGY 5 Responsibilities:

- Covers FCON
- Keeps CORES list for Special Care Babies,
- In charge of presenting at Fetal Boards (if out, fellow needs to arrange cross coverage).
- Coordinates HSHR clinic during Research block
- Covers 24 hour in house call for Resident Retreat

- Takes 1 in house call per month with attending back up
